**What you'll need:**

- **Mod Podge glue** or **Elmer's glue**.

- An old **Paintbrush** and a **dirty rag** to wipe over the surface.
- **Paints** of any kind to paint the sky or river or flowers on your canvas.
- A **Pencil** to outline your landscape.
- **Paper items** you find around the house: old magazines, letters, postcards, cards, envelopes with stamps, patterned paper, wrapping paper, tissue paper, paper towels, even thin fabrics like lace.



You can even take caps, straws or an empty bounty roll and dab them in color. Then make patterns on construction paper or printer paper and use them as part of your collage.
